As our recently approved Strategic Plan encapsulates: "Slí has been in existence since 2019 and has been growing steadily. Our main area of operation is sustainable living (as our name implies) through engagement with youth and communities and a focus on cutting down waste, reuse, recycling and other initiatives." We have continued to grow and have consolidated our systems and procedures over the last 12 months.

Our finance and management practices have improved significantly. We have added to, and updated our policies and procedures in line with Good Government practice, and in line with national guidelines. All policies are available on our website.

As we have grown the need to improve and develop our financial management systems became apparent. We continue to develop these systems which are also available on our website. Please see the financial report. We are grateful to O'Byrne Accounting for their help and advice in getting our finances and procedures in order. Our progress has resulted in increased funding (see programme report) which in turn has meant for the first time we have crossed the financial threshold needed to have our books audited. This went well and we have taken on board the recommendations.
